	WEPOWER Investment Fund, and Kiva Hub 0-Interest loans) that develop Black and Latinx St. Louis
	entrepreneurs with the goals of sparking economic development and creating living-wage jobs. In
	2021, we disbursed 15+ interest free loans (up to \$15k) through the St. Louis Kiva Hub. In 2021,
	we also launched our \$1.5 million investment fund, which will provide Black and Latinx-owned
	businesses access to capital and business coaching with flexible, founder-friendly payment terms
	In addition, we had 10 local Black and Latinx-owned businesses complete our accelerator in 2021;
	each participant received 100+ hours of business coaching, investment readiness training,
	marketing and branding consultation, bookkeeping support, and mentorship over a 6 month period.

	Power Building Academies: Power Building Academy is a 3 month program that provides key
	experiences in leadership development, systems analysis, and grassroots organizing for residents
	seeking to improve the region's economic and early childhood education (ECE) systems. In 2021, we
	trained 21 local residents through the program. In tandem with our Power Building Academy and in
	partnership with others, we have also started a coalition for economic justice, designed policy
	platforms, and led advocacy campaigns including one to spark equitable allocation of resources to
	early childhood education centers and another to address impending school closings within the
	Saint Louis Public Schools.
